Activity of the Day

Writing a story is a little bit like building a house. You start by building at the bottom with the **beginning**, you work your way up to the **middle** and you finish with the roof at the **end**.

Below, on the left, there are three sentences from a story about a boy named Jimmy. On the right, there is a house labelled with those three different parts of a story: the beginning, the middle and the end. Figure out where each sentence belongs in a story and draw a line from the sentence to the part of the house (and the story) where it belongs.

Jimmy is rescued by NASA astronauts.

Jimmy builds a rocket ship that takes him to Mars.

Jimmy gets trapped in an abandoned Martian colony.
